TERMS OF REFERENCE

Complaints & Appeals Committees

Suspension and Expulsion of Members

The Liquor Control and Licensing Act does not supersede the provisions of the General Bylaws in the case of voting members. A member can be evicted from the licensed premises under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act for a period of 24 hours only. Any suspension for more than a 24-hour period must involve specific action under the General Bylaws.

Members

Refer to Article III of the *General Bylaws* with respect to complaints involving members. Branches are advised to make use of the complaint form available from BC/Yukon Command. Use of the form ensures a complaint is constitutionally valid and can properly proceed. Please note that a branch cannot refuse to accept a complaint because this form isn't used. Use of the official complaint form is not mandatory.
