

A Clear Business Plan (Organizational Mission)

- Strategic Plan: outline of long term goals and how the funding will help achieve them
- Assessment of business strategy by a consultant (e.g, Business Development Bank of Canada)
- These tools help ensure alignment with the objectives of the grant opportunity



General Eligibility



- Most grant applications will be very clear about their eligibility requirements
 - Industry type
 - # of employees
 - Business size (revenues)
 - Project size
- Do you need business licenses or permits? In compliance for any/all business/industry regulations?
- Do you have any debts or reporting owed?

Project Readiness

- Again, a clear plan
 - goals
 - timelines
 - expected outcomes
- Feasibility: is the project viable? sustainable?
- Grant Management Plan
 - managing the funds
 - tracking expenses
 - reporting requirements
 - staff support (buy in)



Financial Readiness

- Up-to-date and accurate financial statements
 - Last full fiscal year reviewed or audited
 - Last fiscal year Balance Sheet

Detailed project budget demonstrating how grant funds will be allocated

Helps to demonstrate diversified revenues





WRITING A GRANT

Project/Program Description

- * WHO (The Team)
- * WHAT (The Activities)
- * WHERE (Where will activities take place)
- * WHEN (Timeline and/or Milestones)
- * HOW (Equipment/Supplies needed)



WRITING A GRANT cont'd

- What the funding will help you achieve (goals & objectives)
- Impact the funding will have on: your business

 - your industry
 - your community

- Accessibility
- Community Support/Need
- How you will evaluate/measure success



Ensure Responses Are:

- * Answering the question
- * Compelling
- * Clear
- * Rational

How To Search

Before you start searching, learn more about the Research process and our Search Terms.

Click on a box next to the search criteria, and results will display in a second or two. Click on another box and your results will refresh.

Step 1 - Select your Geographic Scope

- BROADEN your results by selecting both NATIONAL grantmakers and the PROVINCES OR TERRITORIES where you perform work.
- NARROW your results by just selecting one at a time.
- You will get new results as you click on criteria.
- The criteria will display in the above right. You can remove criteria by clicking on the minus sign or by deselecting the boxes.
- Add GLOBAL Grantmakers to your search to list funders who provide support worldwide.

Step 2 - Select one or more of the other terms.

- NARROW your results by selecting more terms.
- BROADEN your results by deselecting any term.
- For Areas of Interest, click the category, and then click a subcategory to get results.
- For Keyword or Grantmaker Name, you do not need to select a Geographic Scope.
